Madfabulous will chart the true story of the fifth Marquess of Anglesey who in the late 19th century eschewed societal protocols of class and gender with his theatrical expressions and lavish social life, spending a multi-million pound fortune before his untimely death aged 29.

The production is looking for trainees who can hit the ground running with enthusiasm and a willingness to learn. No experience in the department is necessary but demonstration of the wider skillset is preferable.

We are looking for someone who is/has:

- A real curiosity and desire to learn the crafts within the Art department.
- Creative passions and interests.
- Organised and punctual.
- Detail-oriented.
- Resourceful.

Requirements

- Applicants must be Welsh or Welsh-based to be considered for this role
- The ability to drive is preferable.
- North Wales-based.

- The production will be base in Bangor and filming on and around the Anglesey and Bangor area. All applicants should be based, or be able to base themselves in this area or close by as no accommodation is provided with this role.
